Abstract

The importance of volunteering has long been acknowledged by EU. This research contains the key finding of a Study on Volunteering in the EU and the main outcome of some national reports from EU member countries on volunteering policies. From the cross-national perspectives of EU, we will see clearly how the concepts related to volunteering are constructed under the European goals: social, economical and political integration. The education and training strategies related to volunteering are discussed so as to have a better understanding of the transformation from ideas to practices in cross-national and, national levels.
